The Rules

A KITTEN'S MIND IS A TERRIBLE THING TO WASTE

Absolute Rules:

- **Your cat must be vet checked before accepted for enrollment. A health certificate needs to be signed by your veterinarian.**

All kittens must have at least one FVRCP vaccine at least 10 days prior to the first class, a first de-worming, and negative results for FeLV and FIV tests.

Kitties must also be pre-checked to insure, no fleas; no ticks; no runny eyes; no ringworm and no apparent upper respiratory infection.

If owners' hear their cat is coughing/sneezing or are in any way feeling their kitty is not feeling well, please do not come to class. Money will be cheerfully refunded. Any cat who does attend, but appears ill in the opinion of an instructor will be asked to leave. Many illnesses in cats are contagious. It is unfair and irresponsible to pass an illness on to another kitten in class.

- **Only cats 8 to 15 weeks are eligible to participate.**
- Do not feed kitties within four hours before class.
- We want children, even babies, to attend the class. But we also want at least one adult to pay attention to each kitty. Children under 7 must be supervised by a second adult. Owners with cats too old to attend may still audit the classes without a kitten.

Equipment You'll Need for Class:

- Purchase leash and harness for your cat and bring them to class (available at most pet stores)
- Cat carrier to safely bring your cat to the class (Handout on acclimating your cat to the carrier will be emailed or Faxed to you before class).
- Brushes won't be shared among cats; please bring your own brush.

Equipment the Class Provides:

- Disposable litter boxes and litter should any kittens feel the spirit.
- Clickers (for clicker training).
- Assorted toys to play with in class.
